

This compensation enhances the involvement of Nurse Practitioners (NPs) in activities led and hosted by the Division of Family Practice (DoFP), particularly in divisions where NPs are not yet full voting members. Reimbursement applications can be submitted [here](#).

Policy Overview

This funding is provided by the Ministry of Health via NP Provincial Initiatives and Programs (NP-PIP).

Compensation for this resource is only available for primary care NPs working in publicly funded settings (PCN independent contractors, HA employed and CHC employed, and those employed through the First Nations Primary Care Initiative). This compensation is **not** available to NPs working in for-profit settings.

****Please note that ALL Division activities compensation submissions must be submitted within 90 days of date of attendance/work completed****

Policy Breakdown

This hourly compensation is only available for time spent on Division led and hosted activities within Divisions that do not yet have NPs as full voting members. Each NP is entitled to compensation for up to **36 hours** per year at a rate of **\$122/hr**.

The annual compensation entitlement is for each current fiscal year (April 1 to March 31). There is no carry forward or carry back of compensation funding available. (e.g., any unused hours from previous fiscal cannot be carried forward to current fiscal year).

Compensation for Divisions activities must have the following criteria met:

- Participation in Divisions led and hosted activities in Divisions that do not yet have NPs as full voting members (See table for list of Divisions)
- Proof/confirmation of attendance in any form that includes the word Divisions/DoFP (e.g. email confirmation from organizer with Divisions/ DoFP email, certificate of attendance with the Divisions/DoFP name included or screenshot of calendar invite with the Divisions/DoFP name included, etc. with Divisions/DoFP name included)

Activities not eligible for compensation include:

- Those compensated by other means (e.g. Divisions with NPs as full voting members). No double-billing is permitted. If the NP is expected to participate as a representative of their employer or another organization, they should be compensated by that party and not the Ministry of Health through NNPBC.
