

Annual licensing reimbursement is available to Nurse Practitioners that are independently contracted in PCN settings within the Province of British Columbia and is provided by the Ministry of Health via NP Provincial Initiatives and Programs (NP-PIP).

Policy Overview

This compensation is only available for primary care NPs working in publicly funded settings (PCN independent contractors and CHC employed, and those employed through the First Nations).

The full licensing cost is reimbursed regardless of FTE (not pro-rated), and subcontractors are also eligible. Both NPs providing longitudinal and NPs providing episodic care qualify (both within PCN settings) are eligible.

Policy Breakdown

Nurse Practitioner licensing fees for the 2026/27 fiscal year are \$1,131.50, and can be reimbursed through [this form](#) from April 1st, 2026 to March 31st, 2027.

*This compensation is not available to NPs working in for-profit settings or to health authority employed NPs.

Reimbursement is only meant to be provided to an NP once per year, so if an NP is working part-time on one compensation model and part-time on another compensation model, they can only be reimbursed once.
