

Abstract Submission Guidelines

2024 NP Conference

The conference planning committee invites you to submit abstract(s) for podium and poster presentations for the 18th annual NP Council conference June 3-5, 2024. For 2024, the conference themes are:

Conference subthemes:

- Championing Connection & Growing Community Scope of practice/legislation/policy
- The NP profession – Diversity and Expansion

We invite topics relevant to the three streams of nurse practitioner practice (Family, Adult, and Pediatric). Submissions in all areas of health care are invited.

- Outline your presentation in maximum of 300 words, including topic title, purpose and or objectives, findings, discussion, and relevance to NP practice.
- Identify two or three questions that will be addressed within the presentation.
- Presentations on research findings should include research purpose, methods, findings, conclusion and clinical relevance.
- All submissions should include three citations applicable to the presentation (max 100 words & not included in maximum word count).

Deadline for Submissions is to January 8th, 2024, 11:59PM (Pacific Time).

Only fully completed submissions will be forwarded to the abstract review committee for consideration. Submissions will be blinded (all demographic information removed) prior to forwarding for review. Each submission will be peer reviewed for relevance to research and knowledge exchange, creativity, clarity, innovation, and applicability to nurse practitioner practice and scholarship.

Please note:

- 1) Only fully completed submissions will be forwarded to the abstract review committee for consideration. Submissions will be blinded (all demographic information removed) prior to forwarding for review. Each submission will be peer reviewed for relevance to research and knowledge exchange, creativity, clarity, innovation, and applicability to nurse practitioner practice and scholarship.
- 2) The presenter consents to their abstract being published in the abstract book and on NNPBC conference related platforms (e.g. website, mobile app).
- 3) If your abstract is selected for the conference program, your presentation slides may be made available on the conference related platforms (as a PDF) during and or after the conference.
- 4) Abstract submission must be approved by all authors noted in the submission.
- 5) All costs related to presenting the topic (travel, accommodation, conference registration) are the responsibility of the presenter(s).
- 6) Presenters are **required to register for a minimum of the day of the conference they are presenting.**
