**ASSOCIATION OF NURSES AND NURSE PRACTITIONERS OF BRITISH COLUMBIA**  
**Constitution**

The name of the Society is Association of Nurses and Nurse Practitioners of British Columbia.

The purposes of the Society are:

- a) to establish a professional organization for all nursing professions within British Columbia;
- b) to promote excellence in nursing practice, education, research, leadership and policy;
- c) to provide a provincial voice and forum for all nursing professionals to contribute to advancing the health of British Columbians through participation in the development of health and social policy;
- d) to establish a professional organization that supports and advances the role of nursing professionals in providing accessible, efficient and effective health care that meets the highest standards;
- e) to collaborate with other professional nursing organizations provincially and nationally;
- f) to foster inter and intraprofessional consultation and collaboration among nursing professionals and other health care providers; and
- g) to do all such other things as are incidental and ancillary to the attainment of the foregoing purposes and the exercise of the powers of the Association.
