

Are you a hospital nurse or nurse practitioner in a BC community with measles in 2025-2026?

Let us know your thoughts on measles vaccination policies for healthcare workers!

We are looking for current patient-facing nurse and nurse practitioners who meet one or more of the following criteria:

- Chose to receive up to two doses of the measles, mumps, and rubella (MMR) vaccine **primarily for protection in the workplace**
- Have **not** received two doses of the MMR vaccine
- Have **not** documented their MMR immune status with their employer

AND

Who work in a hospital in any one of these communities:

Fort St. John, Prince George, Chilliwack, Kelowna, Penticton, Kamloops, Salmon Arm, Vernon, Courtenay



This is a research study. Participants will be asked to speak with us about their experiences with, and views of, MMR vaccine recommendations and policies for healthcare workers. This study is conducted by an independent team at the University of British Columbia, and your employer will not have access to your responses.

Interviews will last approximately 1 hour and be conducted via Zoom or telephone.

Participants will receive a \$50 gift card for their time.
